

# **Scholarships**

First Coast Technical College Education Foundation Scholarships are awarded through an application to the FCTC Foundation and require approval of the Foundation's Scholarship Committee. Scholarships will be limited to funds available for this purpose.

The scholarship will be issued for the program requested on the application and the award may only be used for this program. Scholarships are not transferable to another FCTC program.

Applications for the **2016-17** school year must be submitted to the college no later than 5 PM on **April 7, 2016**. Scholarship recipients will be notified of the scholarship awards within three to five weeks. The FCTC Scholarship award is contingent on the successful attainment of all requirements for high school graduation. Scholarship applicants must meet all requirements for the program they plan to attend.

Students will have 12 months to utilize funds. The scholarships cover registration and tuition fees; additional costs which may include books, supplies, and uniforms are the responsibility of the student. #### Requirements

Adult students planning to or currently enrolled at FCTC may apply. Awards will be based on:

- 1. Recommendation by an instructor and/or guidance counselor from the applicant's school
- 2. Evidence that applicant desires career training at the First Coast Technical College
- 3. A Grade Point Average of 2.5 or higher
- 4. Florida residency
- 5. A completed application from the student with all of the above required information
