

2021-22 Scholarship Application

FCTC Education Foundation Scholarships are awarded through an application and interview process spearheaded by the Foundation's Board of Directors. The Foundation's Scholarship Committee makes the final decisions on all scholarships. Most scholarships have specific criteria, so awards are based on the student's program and the donor's criteria listed on the application. Scholarships must be used for that program and are not transferable to another **FCTC** program.

Applications for this school year must be submitted to the college no later than **1 PM on Tuesday**, **November 16, 2021**. The scholarship applicants must meet all requirements for the program they plan to attend.

Scholarships primarily cover registration and tuition fees; funds may be spent on additional costs such as books, supplies, and uniforms. Upon completion/graduation, if all **FCTC** fees have been met, the student will receive any remaining unspent funds, unless the donor specifies otherwise. Some scholarships specifically ask for unused funds to be returned.

Requirements

Adult students planning to or currently enrolled at FCTC may apply. Awards will be based on:

- 1. Recommendation from an instructor and/or guidance counselor at the applicant's school
- 2. Evidence that applicant desires career training at the First Coast Technical College
- 3. A Grade Point Average of 2.5 or higher
- 4. Florida residency
- 5. A completed application from the student with all of the above required information

- 1. Complete the attached First Coast Technical College Scholarship Application.
- 2. Include an instructor or guidance counselor recommendation with the scholarship form.
- 3. Late applications will not be considered.
